Dear Scholarship Candidate,

The Goizueta Foundation and the University of Georgia are pleased to invite you to apply for a special scholarship that provides assistance to undergraduate students who are both fluent in Spanish and in need of financial assistance.

The \$3,000 yearly scholarship, funded by an endowment from The Goizueta Foundation, is renewable annually. To be considered for this scholarship, students must submit a scholarship application by the March 20th deadline. In order to submit an application, the student must be:

- Admitted as a first-year or transfer student for Fall 2010
- Fluent in Spanish, oral and written expression
- A citizen of the United States or Legal permanent resident
- Have financial need as determined by the UGA Office of Student Financial Aid beyond the assistance of other scholarship received, including the Georgia HOPE scholarship.

Preference is give to Georgia residents and fluency in Spanish will be determined by certification from the head of the Spanish Language program at your high school or college. Financial need will be determined by the submission of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and reviewed by the UGA Office of Student Financial Aid. Selection for the scholarship will be made by the Scholarship Committee of the Office of Admissions.

The Goizueta Foundation Scholarships are renewable for up to four years (three years if the student enters UGA as a transfer student) or until the student receives his /her baccalaureate degree, whichever occurs first. Goizueta Scholars must maintain a semester course load of at least 12 hours, with a cumulative grade point average of at least a 2.8 and must complete the FAFSA form annually to prove financial need beyond the funds provided by other scholarships including the HOPE scholarship.

I hope that you will be interested in this opportunity and will submit the enclosed scholarship application by **March 20, 2010**. First-year students must submit their application for admission by the **January 15, 2010** deadline. Transfer students must apply and be admissible for Fall semester 2010. The transfer application for admission must be submitted no later than **March 1, 2010**.
