Dear Scholarship Candidate,

The Goizueta Foundation and the University of Georgia are pleased to invite you to apply for one of three scholarships that provide assistance to an undergraduate student who is both fluent in Spanish and in need of financial assistance.

The \$3,000 scholarship, funded by The Goizueta Foundation, is renewable annually and will be awarded to three admitted students selected from students submitting a scholarship application by the March 15 deadline. In order to submit an application, the student must be:

- Admitted as a first-year or transfer student for Fall 2006
- Fluent in Spanish, oral and written expression
- Have family that currently reside in the United States
- Have financial need as determined by the UGA Office of Student Financial Aid beyond the assistance of other scholarships received including the Georgia HOPE scholarship

Fluency in Spanish will be determined by certification from the head of the Spanish Language program at your high school or college. Financial need will be determined by the submission of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and review by the UGA Office of Student Financial Aid. Selection for the scholarship will be made by the Scholarship Committee of the Office of Admissions.

The Scholarships are renewable for up to four years (three years if the student enters UGA as a transfer student) or until the student receives his/her baccalaureate degree, whichever occurs first. Goizueta Scholars must maintain a semester course load of at least 12 hours, maintain a cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 and must complete the FAFSA form annually to prove financial need beyond the funds provided by other scholarships including the HOPE scholarship.

I hope that you will be interested in this opportunity and will submit your scholarship application by **March 15, 2006**. First-year students must submit their application for admissions by **January 15, 2006**. Transfer students must apply and be admissible for the Fall semester. The transfer application for admissions must be submitted no later than **March 1, 2006**.
