

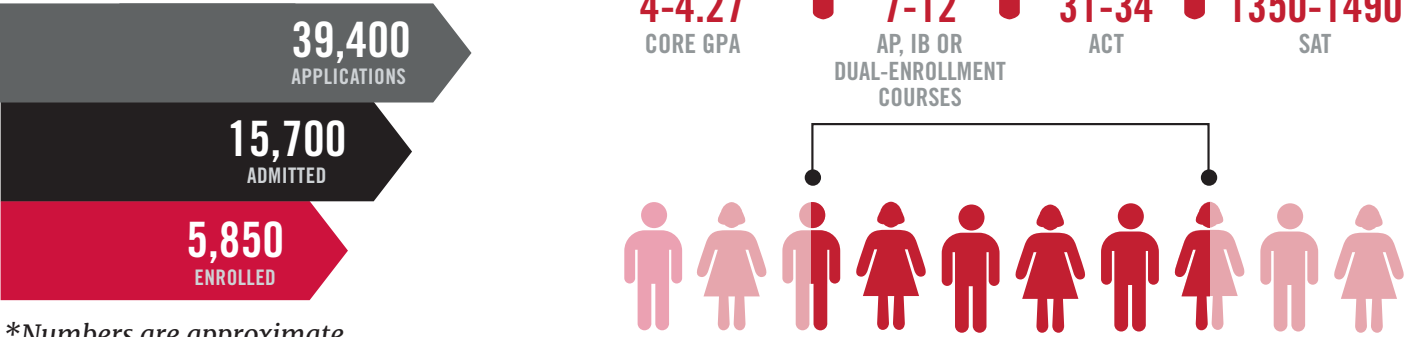

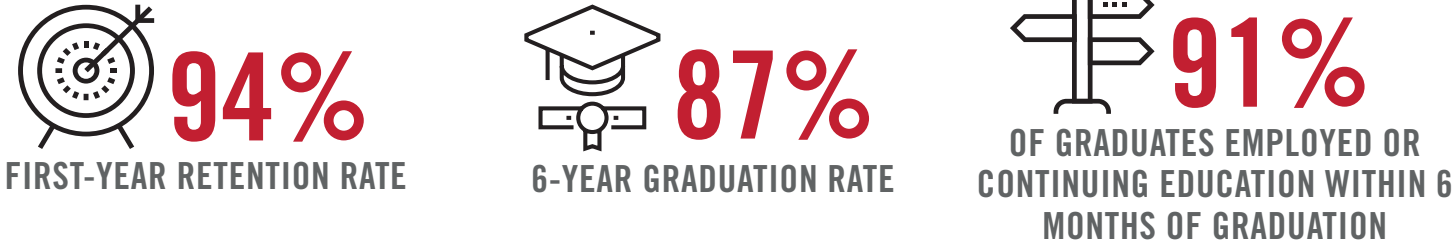

FALL 2021 APPLICATION NUMBERS AND ADMITTED STUDENTS MIDDLE-50%

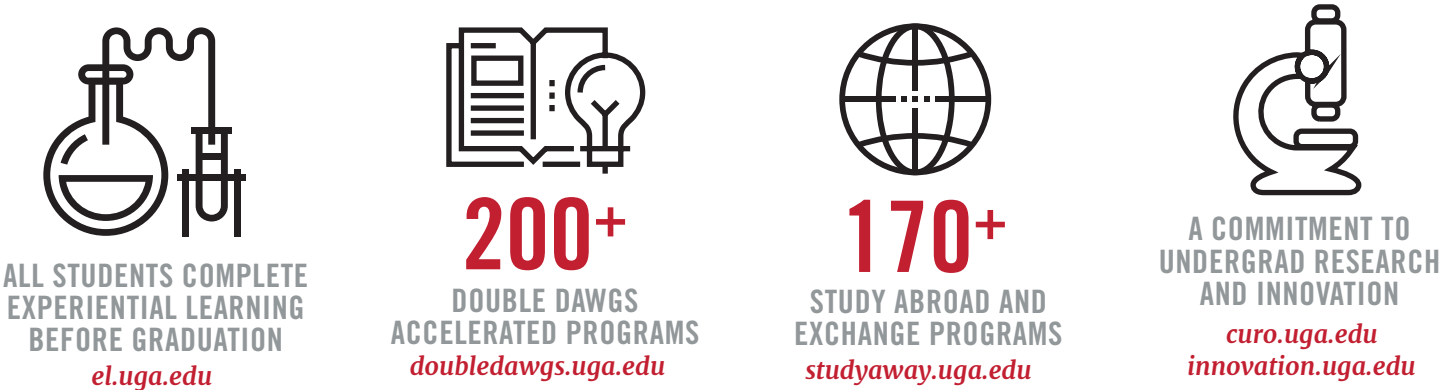

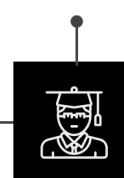
